#### GENERAL RULES

The competition is open for all member clubs of the Austrian Figure Skating Association and all ISU member federations and their clubs.

The Competition will be based on the ÖWO 2017, the ISU General and Special Regulations and the relevant ISU Communications.

For skaters from Austria: In one season a skater can only compete in recreational OR high performance competitions.

## MUSIC

All music must be on CD with the skater's name, nation, length of the program and category. In addition, competitors must provide a back-up drive for their program.

## DRAW

Draw for the starting order will be done after the entry deadline on January 5th 2018 electronically. The starting order and the time schedule will be sent by e-mail to all entering clubs and also be published on our webpage:

## JUDGES AND TECHNICAL PANEL

The Judges and Technical Panel will be invited by the Organizing Committee, also accepting Judges and a members of the Technical Panel with national qualification. The expenses for hotel accommodation will be covered for the invited Referees, Judges, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialists and Data / Video Operators. Travel fees will be paid based on economy fare by train.

### **Entries must contain:**

- 1) Name and address of the club
- 2) Name of the competition, indicating the starting group
- 3) Name and date of birth of the participant
  
- 4) confirmation of eligibility of the entered skaters
- 5) Confirmation of the existence of a valid sports medicine safety certificate -ÖWO rule 115.1.8 (only for austrian skaters)
- 6) Valid skaters license 2017/18 (only for austrian skaters)
- 7) Planned Program Content Sheet

**Entries which do not correspond the requirements of the numbers 1-7 may not be accepted by the organizer. Entry/result lists and if necessary, photographs of participants will be published on the internet. By submitting to the competition, the skaters or their legal representatives agree to the publication.**

## **LIABILITY**

By entering a skater to the competition all competitors confirm bellows statement:

I confirm that I am in good health and have no medical condition that would impede my ability to compete or be detrimental to any other competitor's ability to compete or cause harm whatsoever to any person. I understand that I participate in an Interclub Competition at my own risk and that no liability is accepted by the Organizers and or their Association for any death, injury, damage or loss sustained by me during this event.

## **CATEGORIES:**

- Competing in more than one category is not permitted
- Vocal music is allowed
- There is no bonus for elements executed in the second half of the program

Cutoff date for all age categories is July 1<sup>st</sup> 2017

### Girls and boys, younger than 6 years

Free Program: 1.30 min (+/-10sec)

- A max. 3 jump elements (permitted jumps: Waltz Jump, single Salchow, single Toeloop)
- A maximum of one (1) jump combination / sequence. Jump combinations can contain only two (2) jumps. A jump sequence can contain any number of jumps, but only the two most difficult jumps will be counted.
- A maximum of two (1) spin (min. 3 rev.) on either one (1) foot or on two (2) feet
- A maximum of one Step Sequence (StSq Base) utilizing half of the ice surface.

The step sequence has a fixed Base value and will be evaluated in GOE only.  
Features up to Level 1 will be counted.

## Youth Group 1

### Girls and boys, younger than 8 years

Free program 2:00 min (+/-10sec)

- A maximum of 4 jump elements (permitted jumps: Waltz jump, all single jumps, except single axel, repetition of jumps is allowed)
- There may be up to two (2) jump combinations or sequences. Jump combinations can contain only two (2) jumps. A jump sequence can contain any number of jumps, but only the two most difficult jumps will be counted.
- A maximum of two spins with either the same or a different abbreviation (min. 3 rev.)
- A maximum of one Step Sequence (StSq Base) utilizing half of the ice surface.

The step sequence has a fixed Base value and will be evaluated in GOE only.  
Features up to Level 2 will be counted.

## **Youth Group 2**

### **Girls and boys born between 8 and 10 years of age**

Free program 2:00 min (+/-10sec)

- A maximum of 4 jump elements (permitted jumps : Waltz jump, all single jumps, except single axel, repetition of jumps is allowed)
- There may be up to two (2) jump combinations or sequences. Jump combinations can contain only two (2) jumps. A jump sequence can contain any number of jumps, but only the two most difficult jumps will be counted.
- A maximum of two spins with either the same or a different abbreviation (min. 4 rev.)
- A maximum of one Step Sequence (StSq Base) utilizing half of the ice surface.

The step sequence has a fixed Base value and will be evaluated in GOE only. Features up to Level 2 will be counted.

## **Youth Group 3**

### **Girls and boys born between 10 and 14 years of age**

Free program 2:00 min (+/-10sec)

- A maximum of 4 jump elements (permitted jumps : Waltz jump, all single jumps, except single axel, repetition of jumps is allowed)

- There may be up to two (2) jump combinations or sequences. Jump combinations can contain only two (2) jumps. A jump sequence can contain any number of jumps, but only the two most difficult jumps will be counted.
- A maximum of two different spins, one of which must be a combination spin without change of foot (min 5 rev.).
- A maximum of one Step Sequence (StSq Base) utilizing the full ice surface.

The step sequence has a fixed Base value and will be evaluated in GOE only. Features up to Level 2 will be counted.

## **Youth Group 4**

### **Girls and boys, between 14 and 16 years of age**

Free Program 2:30 min (+/-10sec)

- A maximum of 5 jump elements (permitted jumps, Waltz jump, all single jumps, including single axel, every jump in isolation can only be executed twice).
- There may be up to two (2) jump combinations or sequences. Jump combinations can contain only two (2) jumps. A jump sequence can contain any number of jumps, but only the two most difficult jumps will be counted. Each listed jump may be performed a maximum of two (2) times.

A maximum of two different spins, one of which must be a combination spin with a change of foot (min 6 rev.).

A maximum of one Choreographic Sequence.

The Choreo Sequence has a fixed Base value and will be evaluated in GOE only. Features up to Level 3 will be counted.

## Juniors plus Group 5

### Ladies and Men, 16 years and older

Free Program 2:30 min (+/-10sec)

- A maximum of 5 jump elements (permitted jumps: Waltz jump, all single jumps, including single axel and two (2) different double jumps). There may be up to three (3) jump combinations or sequences. Jump combinations can contain only two (2) jumps. A jump sequence can contain any number of jumps, but only the two most difficult jumps will be counted. Each listed jump may be performed a maximum of two (2) times.
- A maximum of two different spins, one of which must be a combination spin with a change of foot (min 6 rev.).
- A maximum of one Choreographic Sequence.

The Choreo Sequence has a fixed Base value and will be evaluated in GOE only. Features up to Level 3 will be counted.
